- This will help in delivery of right justice in a faster manner.

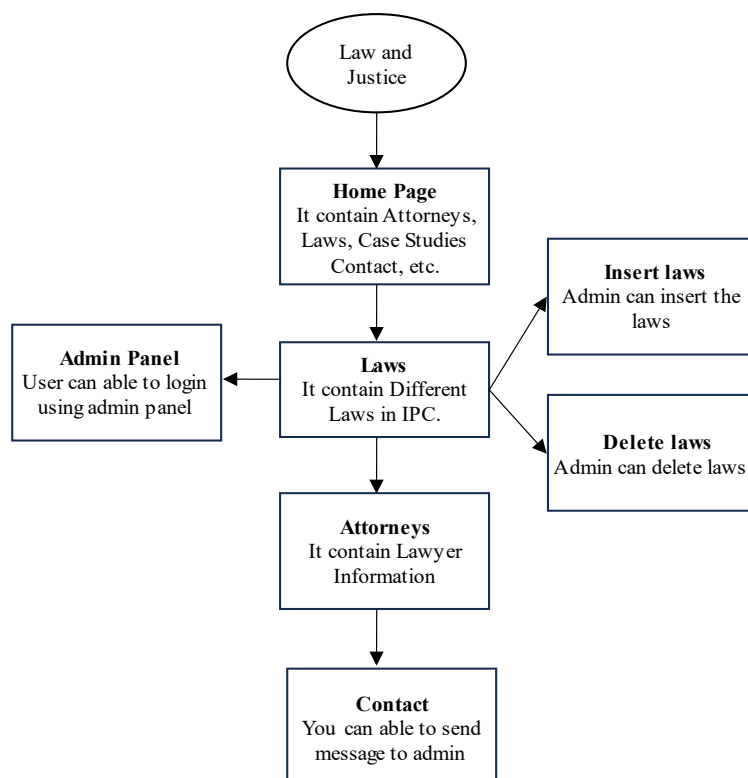
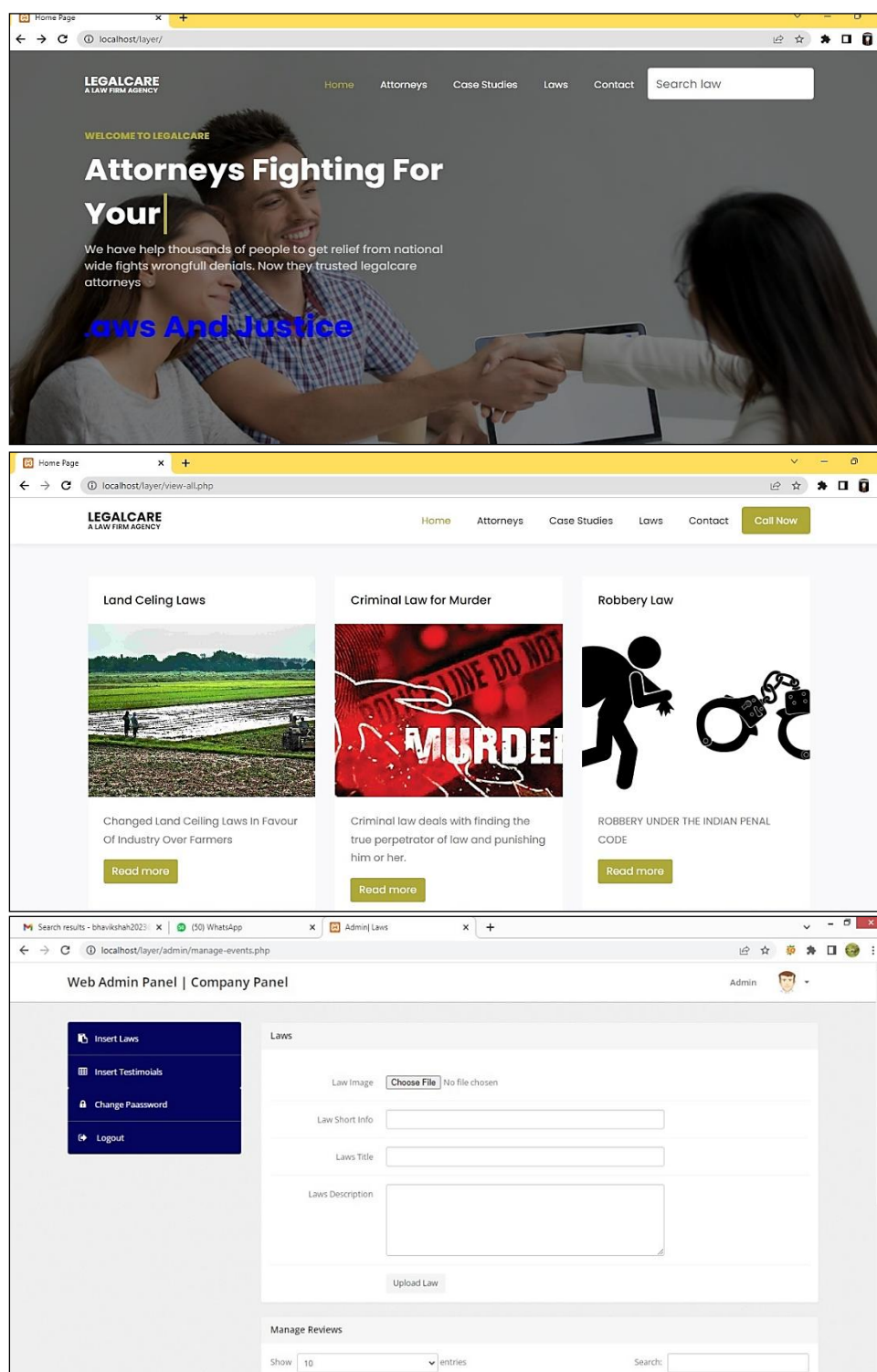


Figure 1. Architecture design of law and justice.

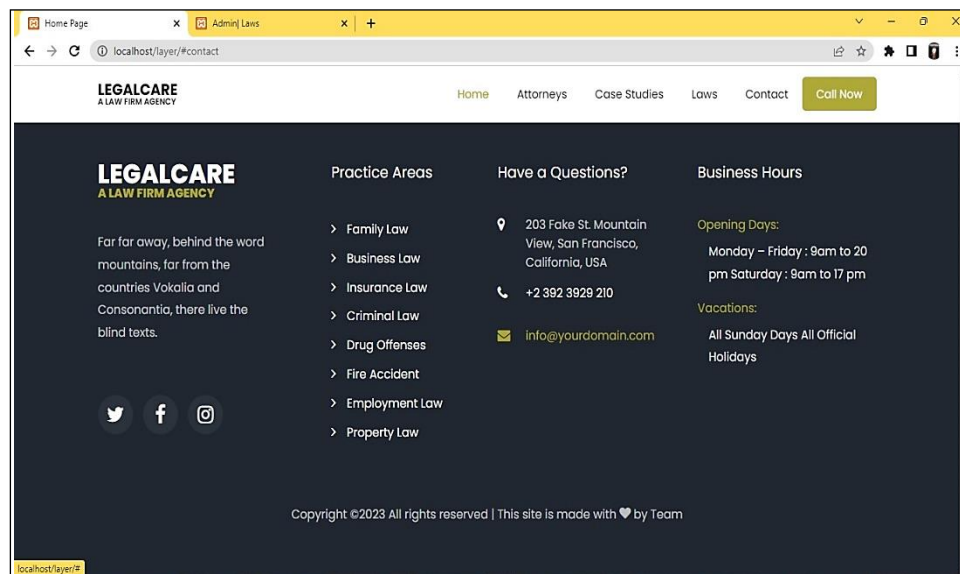


Figure 2. Law and justice platforms.
